## **Part-Time Gaming Commission Compliance Officer**

This is a part-time position and a set number of hours are not guaranteed.

### **SUMMARY OF DUTIES:**

- **This position is shift work and must be willing to work days, nights and weekends.** Shift examples: (1) 5:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; (2) 5:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.; (3) 3:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.; or (4) 5:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m.
- Responsible for monitoring casino gaming operations; determining casino compliance with regulations and applicable standards.
- Prepares reports and supporting documentation related to incidents and compliance activities.
- Receives complaints from the public and initiates action as appropriate.
- Performs special compliance inspections as circumstances warrant.
- Oversees the storage, issuance and destruction of all gaming equipment.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- High School diploma or equivalent.
- Must be twenty-one (21) years of age.
- Able to pass a State Police background investigation.
- Must have the ability to learn, understand, and apply the regulations governing the rules and conduct of authorized games, gaming equipment and devices.
- Must possess the ability to deal with general public, casino personnel, and Federal and State officials.
- May be required to pick up twenty-five (25) pounds and will be required to cut playing cards.

**PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO QUALIFIED NATIVE AMERICANS PURSUANT TO PUBLIC LAW 93-638 AND THE INDIAN SELF-DETERMINATION AND EDUCATION ASSISTANCE ACT AND THE INDIAN CIVIL RIGHTS ACT 25 U.S.C. 450e(b).**
