Gaming Commission Chairman

SCOPE OF WORK:

The Chitimacha Tribal Gaming Commission is the gaming regulatory entity of the Chitimacha Tribe of Louisiana. The Commission Chairman, as head of the Commission, is responsible for direction and guidance of the Tribal Gaming Commission. The Chairman is responsible for the general oversight and operation of the Commission activities and personnel. The Chairman shall establish and maintain effective, professional and cordial working relationships with gaming management, Commission personnel, tribal entities, and other individuals or representative of public and private agencies to ensure the proper, efficient and effective regulation of the Tribe's gaming activities.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be capable of ensuring that the Gaming Commission operates and function as an independent tribal regulatory entity in accordance with applicable law.
- Must be capable of balancing the regulatory requirements with the business interest of the Tribe in advancing the gaming enterprise.
- Must be able to establish and maintain a sound regulatory framework, which promotes the integrity of the gaming operation.
- Must have a high sense of ethics and fairness.
- Must have good work discipline which includes punctuality, dependability, and accountability.
- Must have high standards of integrity and professionalism while serving as Chairman.

Subject to Pre-employment and Random Drug Testing; a Background Investigation will be required and preference will be given to qualified Chitimacha Tribal Members and other Native American applicants.
