

Position Announcement:

Chitimacha Gaming Commission

Part-Time Gaming Commission Compliance Officer

SUMMARY: Under the general supervision of the Gaming Commission Chairman and the direct supervision of the Shift Supervisor (when applicable), the Compliance Officer is responsible for monitoring casino gaming operations; determining casino compliance with regulations and applicable standards; receiving complaints from the public and taking appropriate action; and related work as required.

EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE: High School Diploma or GED, twenty-one (21) years of age and must have the initiative, be conscientious and possess the ability to deal with the general public, other staff members, casino employees and management personnel, and federal and state officials.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be able to pass a comprehensive Louisiana State Police background investigation and receive State Certification and be licensed by the Tribal Gaming Commission.
- Must be able to work day and night shifts.

PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO QUALIFIED NATIVE AMERICANS PURSUANT TO PUBLIC LAW 93-638 AND THE INDIAN SELF-DETERMINATION AND EDUCATION ASSISTANCE ACT AND THE INDIAN CIVIL RIGHTS ACT 25 U.S.C.
