TITLE OF POSITION: POLICE COMMUNICATIONS OFFICER

DEPARTMENT: TRIBAL POLICE DEPARTMENT

JOB SUMMARY: Answers incoming emergency and non-emergency calls to the Police, Fire, and/or Emergency Medical Departments. Categorizes calls, dispatches to appropriate staff, delivers relevant and important information to officers and callers, and monitors calls to ensure the safety of officers, firefighters, and/or emergency technicians. Participates in law enforcement and crime prevention services to maintain a safe and secure community within the Chitimacha Tribe jurisdiction and surrounding jurisdictions as required.

EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE:

High School Diploma or GED AND Two (2) years of experience in communications work or related field.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be able to successfully pass a background screening/investigation.
- Pre-employment and random drug screen.
- Valid driver's license is required when driving vehicles for work-related purposes.
